- The Regional Gathering in August 2016 will give a member State Sanctioned Event Credit (members sign in with Shooter)
- Does Arizona want to host Regional Gathering 2017? If a Chapter is interested in hosting this event, the CEB should contact SHOOTER.
- The CVMA Nationals will come to Region 8 in 2021. This seems a long way out, but with CVMA growing, reserving hotels and locations is a major hurdle best tackled early. No state in Region 8 has assumed the role of host yet for the Region 8 hosted Nationals event in 2021. The 2011 event was in Colorado Springs, CO and the 2005 event was in Taos, NM.
